## Questions 152–154 The Westminster Larger Catechism

Leader: What does every sin deserve at the hands of God?

Congregation: Every sin, even the least, being against the sovereignty, goodness, and holiness of God, and against His righteous law, deserves His wrath and curse, both in this life, and that which is to come; and cannot be expiated but by the blood of Christ.

Leader: What does God require of us, that we may escape His wrath and curse due to us by reason of the transgression of the law?

Congregation: That we may escape the wrath and curse of God due to us by reason of the transgression of the law, He requires of us repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ, and the diligent use of the outward means whereby Christ communicates to us the benefits of His mediation.

Leader: What are the outward means whereby Christ communicates to us the benefits of His mediation?

Congregation: The outward and ordinary means whereby Christ communicates to His church the benefits of His mediation, are all His ordinances; especially the Word, sacraments, and prayer: all which are made effectual to the elect for their salvation.
